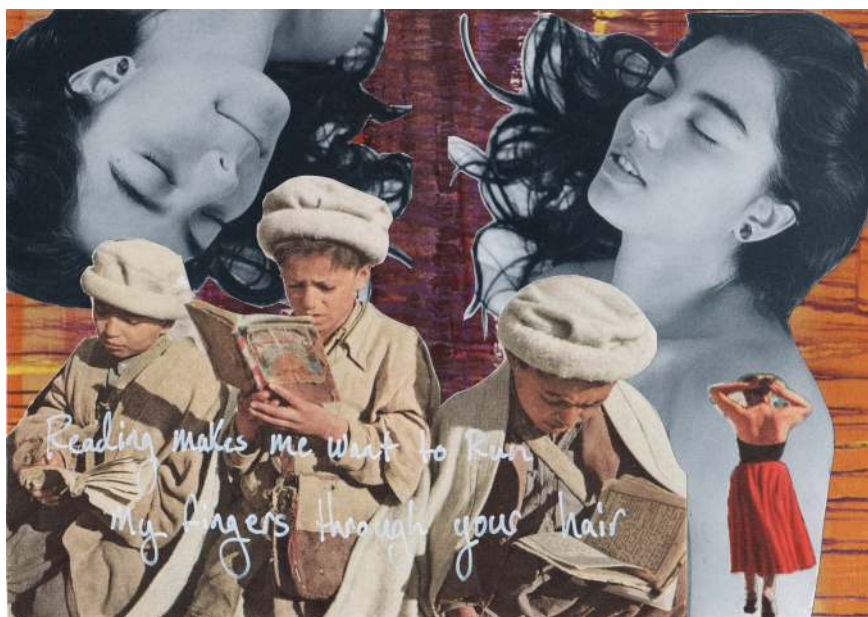
The last line is a twist of my own. Gibran himself suggested,

for love, if it finds you worthy, directs your course.

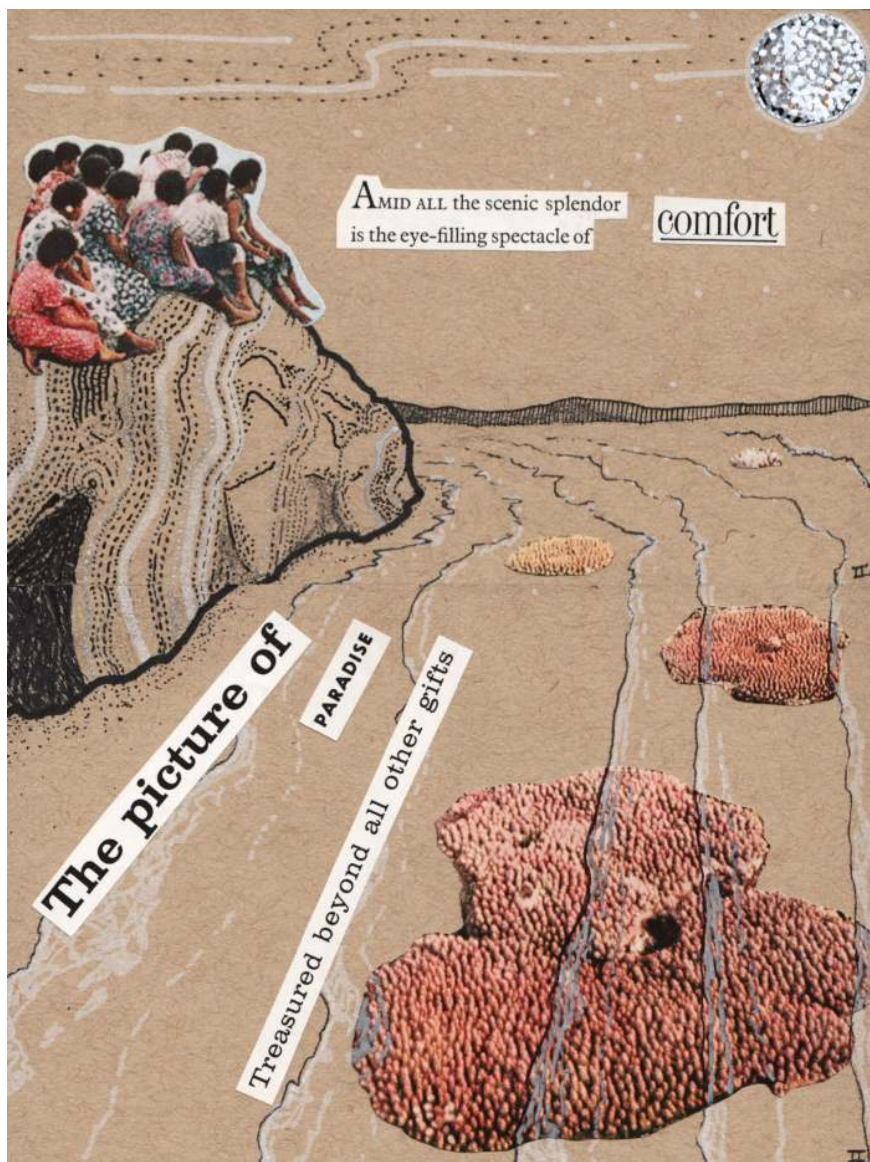

resound.

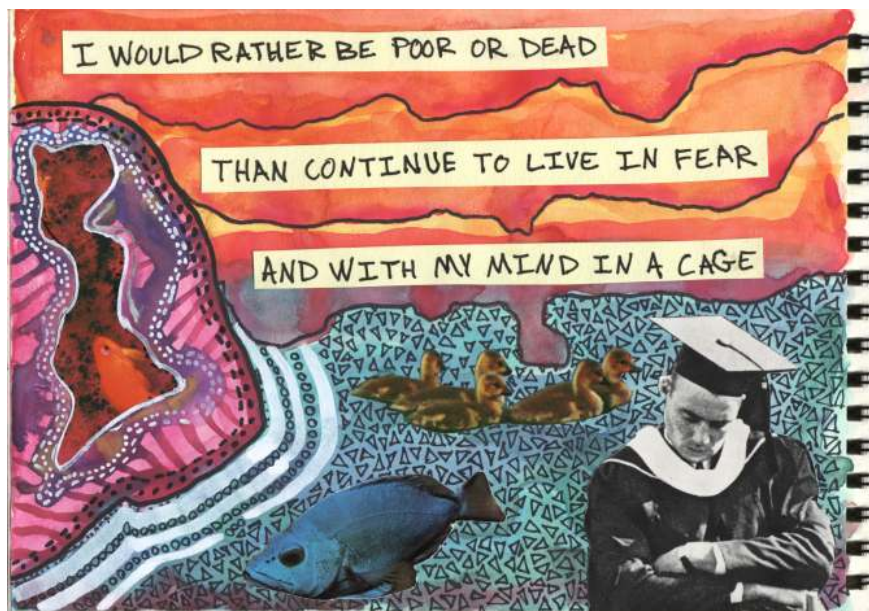
